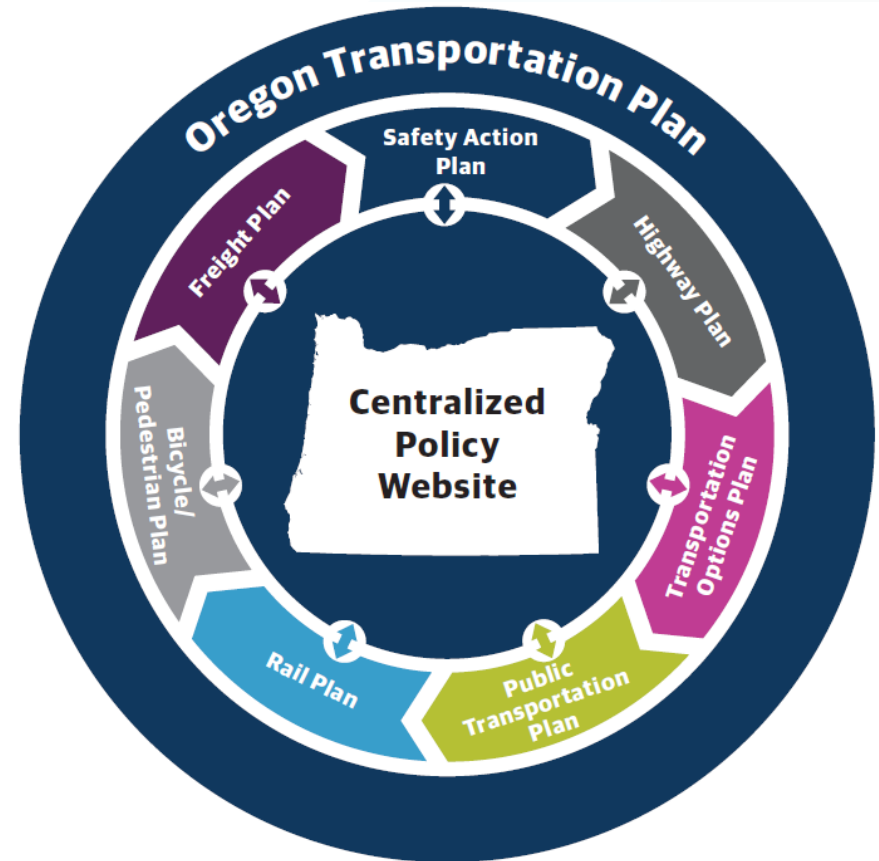
Oregon Public Transportation Plan Vision

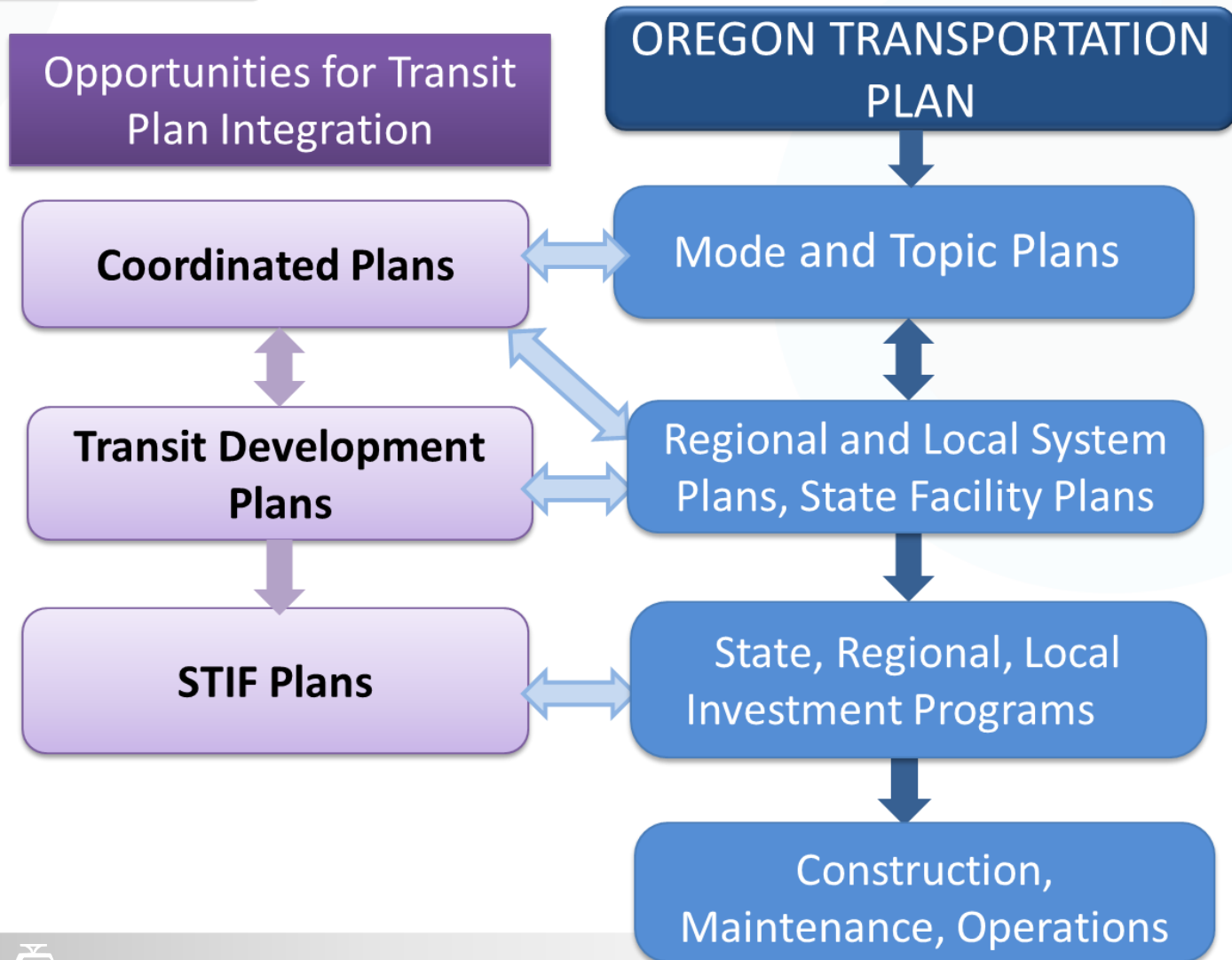


What is the Oregon Public Transportation Plan?

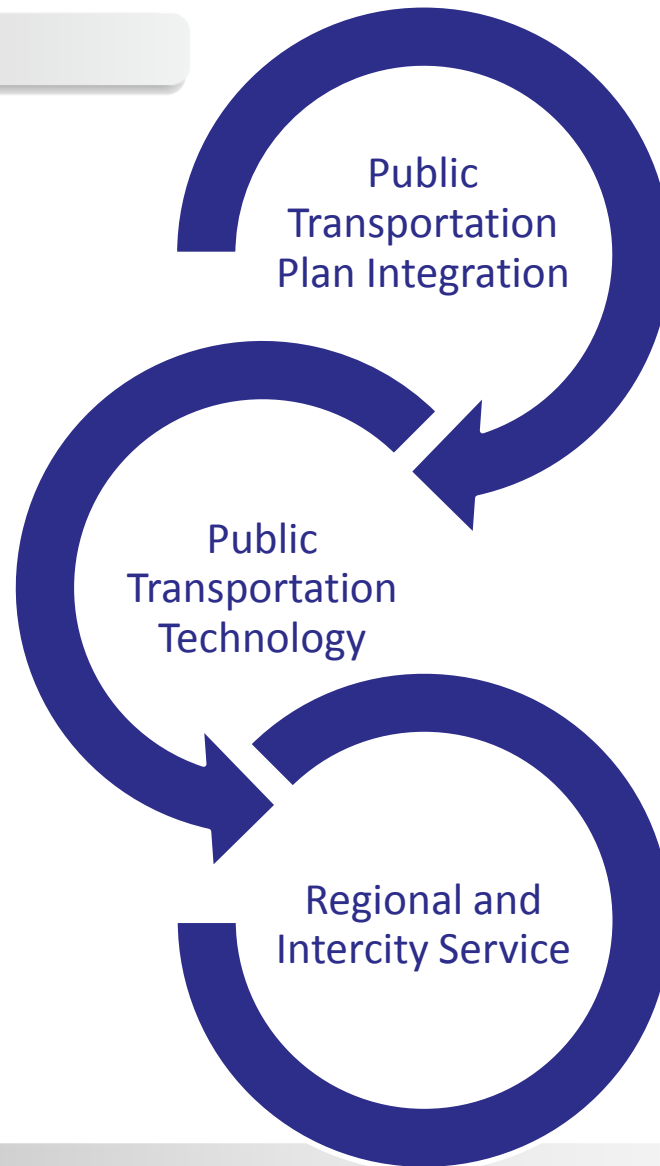
